
WARNING - The safety lattice for children must not be used in case of damage or loss of individual parts.


WARNING - Do not install this child safety gate across windows.

WARNING - Always use the suction cups provided.

CAUTION!

- This child safety gate is intended for domestic use only.
- This safety gate is equipped with a manual locking system.
- Always check that the safety gate is locked/latched properly.
- This door guard is intended for children aged up to 24 months. As children develop at different rates, this is only a guide.
- The safety gate must only be installed between solid, clean and smooth door jambs / walls.
- The stair safety gate must only be fitted between two solid elements (stair rail and wall).
- · Older children might climb over the gate.
- Never leave your child unattended, this is the best way of protecting it from accidents.
- Once installed, check against the instructions that the safety gate is firmly installed and functioning.
- Regularly check that the gate is firmly in place, that it is in a good general condition and that the locking mechanisms function.
- Only spares supplied by the manufacturer are to be used.
- Please check regularly that no screws have worked loose! Retighten the screws, if necessary.
- · To clean, use warm water only.
- If fitted properly, the safety gate conforms to EN 1930 : 2011.

- An incorrect assembly or positioning of this safety lattice for children can be dangerous.
- If the safety gate is being used at the top of the stairs to prevent children from falling it should be installed on the landing, not on
 one of the steps (Position " A "). If the safety gate is to be used at the bottom of the stairs to prevent a child from climbing up, then
 it should be installed in the front on the bottom step. (Position " B ")
